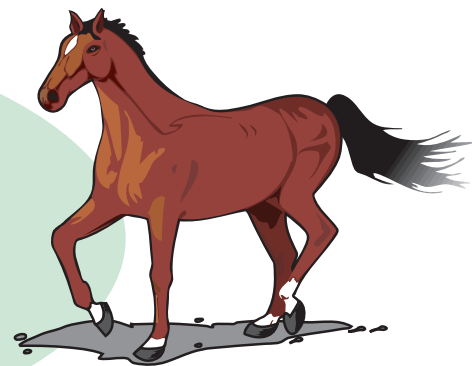


# Camp Chaverim

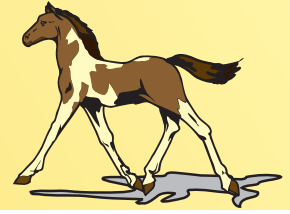


# Camp Pitsala

8<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> Grade

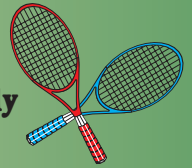

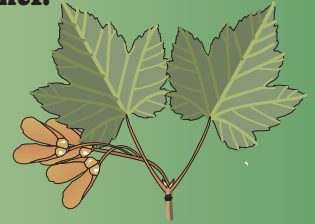

Baltimore! We will stay at the JCC, visit the city and go to a professional baseball game. More details to follow.

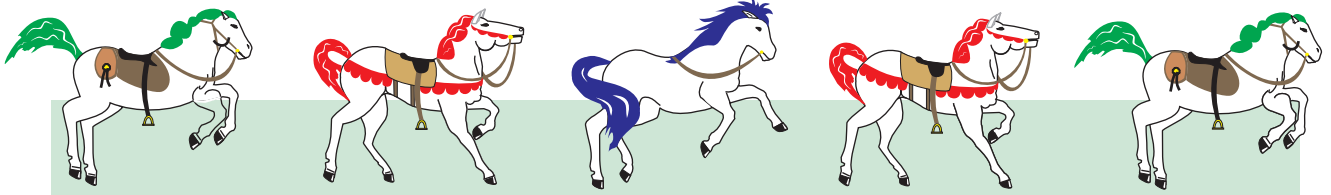

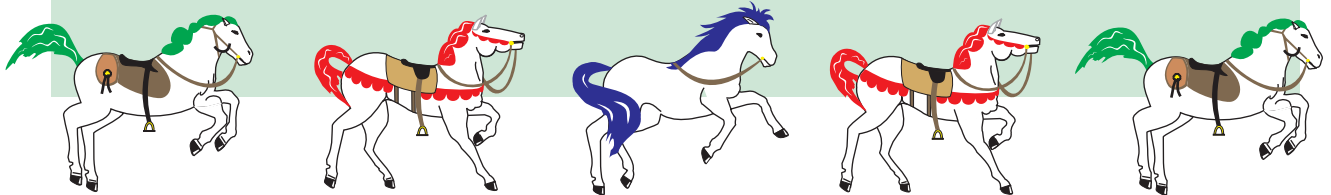

## Extended Camp Care

This program offers childcare beyond regular camp hours from 8:00 - 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 - 6:00 p.m.

### Member Fees:

\$3.50 for a.m. care per day

\$5.00 for p.m. care per day.

## Scholarship Information

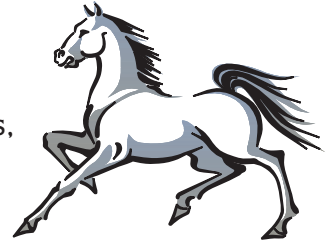

We understand that during the summer there may be a week during the camp season that you may have planned other activities. While it is not our policy to pro-rate camp sessions, you may submit a two-week written notice for consideration to have one of the sessions pro-rated to one week at a rate of 65% per session. This request can only be considered if you have signed up for more than two sessions of camp. Please submit your request to the attention of the Camp Director.
