The Stein Family College Scholarship is dedicated in loving memory of Arlene Stein, wife of Gerald Stein and mother of Steve, Lisa, Craig and Debbie.

This scholarship was created to express Arlene's deep love of learning and her strong belief that higher education should be accessible to all.



Eligibility

Jewish students who have a strong academic record, have provided service to the community, and demonstrate financial need are invited to apply.

Students must be accepted to or attending an accredited undergraduate college or university program with parents who are permanent residents of the Hampton Roads area of Virginia.

Scholarship Requirements

The Stein Family College Scholarship is an **annual** grant that provides one scholarship up to \$10,000 for a freshman. Subsequent years will see added scholarships for a sophomore, junior, and senior such that a qualifying and re-qualifying entering freshman may be awarded up to a maximum of \$40,000 towards his/her college education.

Applicants please note:

- Applications will be available online at www.jewishva.org beginning December 18, 2009, for academic year 2010-2011.
- Must be a full time student, and under the age of 24, as of January 1, 2010.
- All students are welcome to reapply each year, unless otherwise noted.
- Applications must be **received** by April 9, 2010 (postmark does not apply). Applications should be mailed or delivered to:
